

# The NORTHWEST ROTARY TILLER



## For Seed Bed Preparation, "Till Plant" and Minimum Tillage Farming

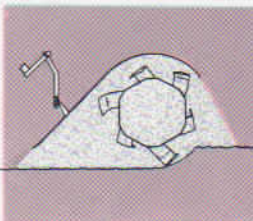
The Northwest Tiller is a rugged, heavy duty tiller built to match today's more powerful tractors. The large illustration shows a standard 14 ft. Northwest Tiller behind a 130 H.P. tractor tilling Milo maize stubble. The unit was bought by Dorsey D. Schad of Gruver, Texas, from Crawford Implement Co. of Spearman. Even though the ground is very dry and hard, the Tiller is getting excellent break-up and good mulching of stubble.

The smaller illustration shows more of the versatility of the Northwest Tiller. It's a bedder and incorporator as well. This standard 14 ft. tiller equipped with four bed-formers is preparing a California cotton field.

Northwest Tillers are available in sizes from 4 ft. to 14 ft. in 1 ft. increments and may be used integrally or equipped with drawn hitch.



Bed Formers are adjustable to create desired bed and row sizes A, B and C.



This is the action of the heavy, wide blades as they chop into the surface, breaking up clods to desired size. Soil is thoroughly mixed for maximum chemical mixing and to form the perfect seed bed.
