




Important, too, is the fact that each of these tools is low in cost, far less than corresponding complete implements. Thus you can make real money savings right from the start.

There are other important advantages. The John Deere is close-coupled; the entire outfit is compact and

easy to maneuver. You can farm close to fence rows, along irrigation ditches; at row ends you can make short, quick turns; you can use more of the field for production, reduce waste land to a minimum.

Simple, positive controls regulate hydraulic power to raise, lower or set the tools at exactly the working position you desire. Holding pressure can be exerted on the carrier when tools are in the ground to assure deep, even penetration in either hard or soft ground.


All in all, the John Deere Integral Tool Carrier is a time, work, and money saver that will hold your farm equipment investment to a minimum and, at the same time, increase the number of jobs you can do. The John Deere is ruggedly built. Sturdy side arms are made of high-quality steel and are arc-welded for extra strength. This assures ample strength to handle all tools efficiently. This carrier is the product of quality materials and quality workmanship always yours in implements that bear the name John Deere.


There's hardly any work at all to attaching working tools to the John Deere Integral Tool Carrier. Simply drive up to the working tool, such as the bulldozer, above, lining up the coupler hooks above the fittings of the tool carrier, as shown at the right. Raise the fittings into the hooks and pick up the attachment, by hydraulic control. Then place two pins in place, one each fitting at point "A" and you're ready for work. It's as simple as that!

Many rear-mounted tools, which hook up in exactly the same manner, can be attached without leaving the tractor seat. To remove the implement-attachment, at the front or rear, simply reverse the hookup procedure.



Field adjustments are easy to make, simply by making a few turns on the convenient side-arm adjustment levers (right). You can raise or lower either side of the bar, level the bar, or give the attachment proper suction.

Where a holding (or penetrating) pressure is desired, the pin is set at point "A" (shown at the left). Lifting hooks, rigidly mounted on the bulldozer blade, slip snugly into the carrier fittings. Slip pins at both fittings lock the attachment securely in place and you're ready for work.
